



PRONOUN

Rule of preference :-

In case more than one pronouns are used in a sentence then following rule will apply :-

- ① If 1st person and 2nd person are used together then give preference to 2nd person

eg. You and I love to play cricket.

- ② If 1st person and 3rd person are used together then give preference to 3rd person

eg. she and I

- ③ If 2nd and 3rd person are used together then give preference to 2nd person

eg. you and she

- (2) Possessive pronouns: these pronouns are used to show ownership or possession (अपनी वस्तु या व्यक्ति से संबंध या अधिकार बताने हेतु)

Ram ~~loves~~ loves his parents
The house you see over there is ours

This table shows the possessive pronoun used for different pronouns

Personal pronoun	I	we	You	he	she	they
Possessive pronoun	mine	ours	yours	his	hers	theirs
